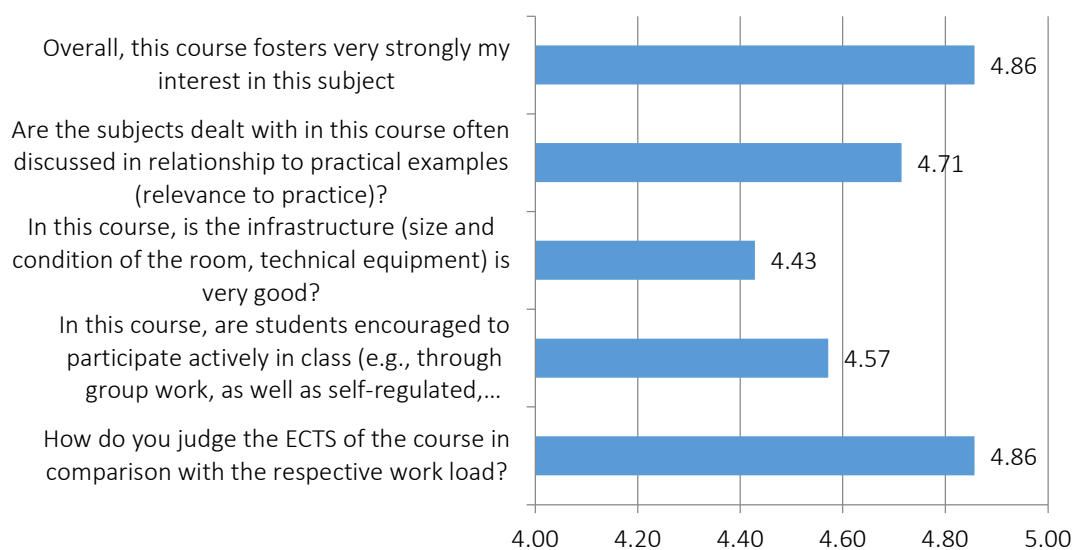
Description

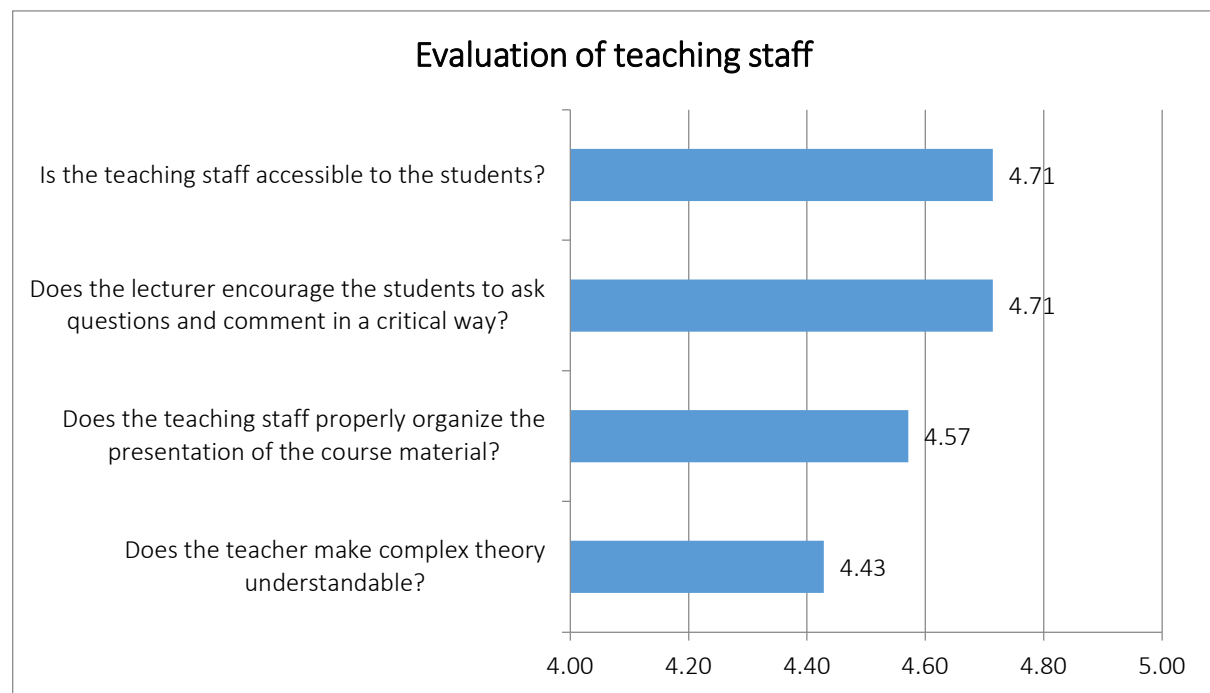
Results of evaluation of teaching staff

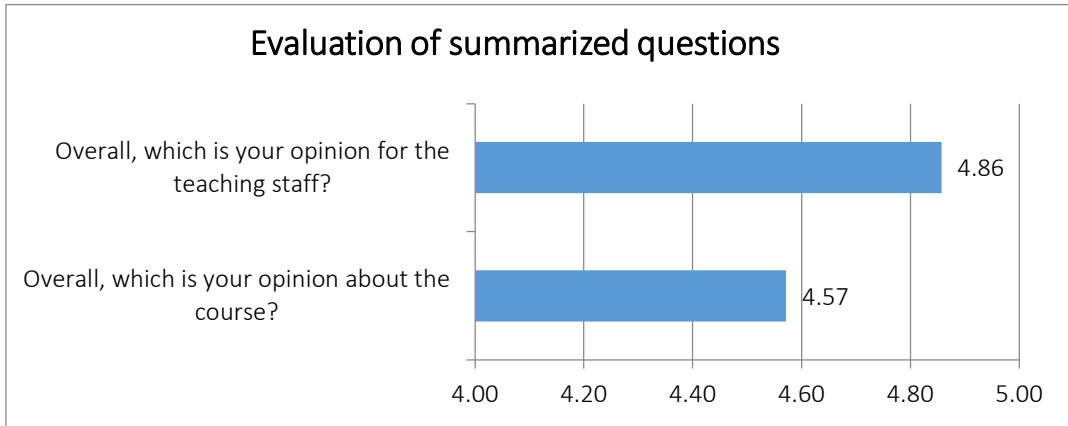
