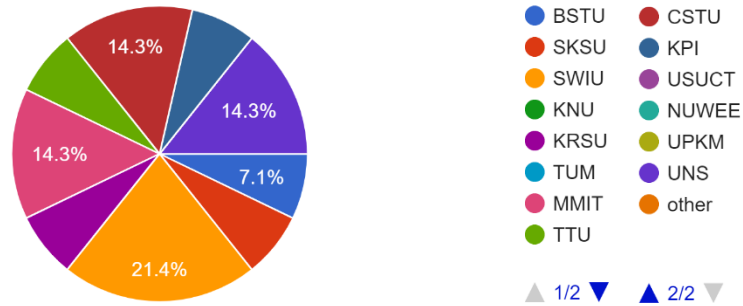


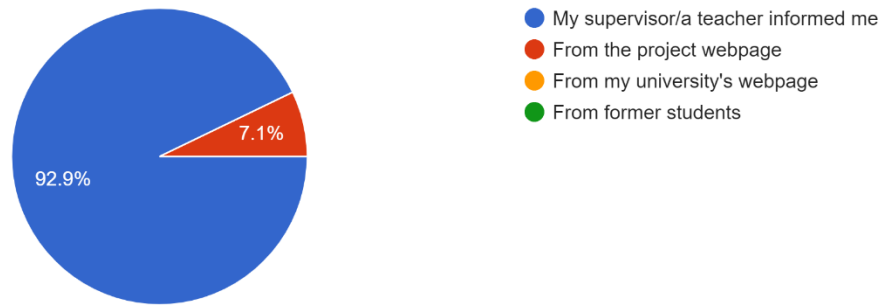

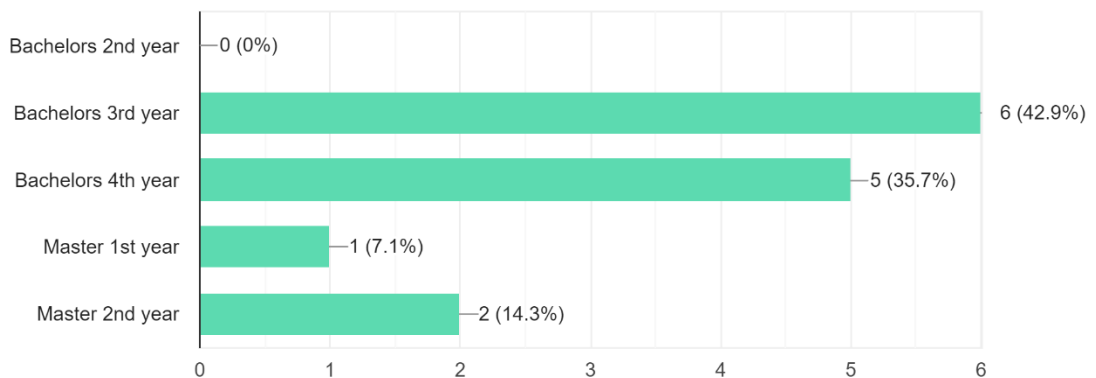
How did you learn about the fellowship?

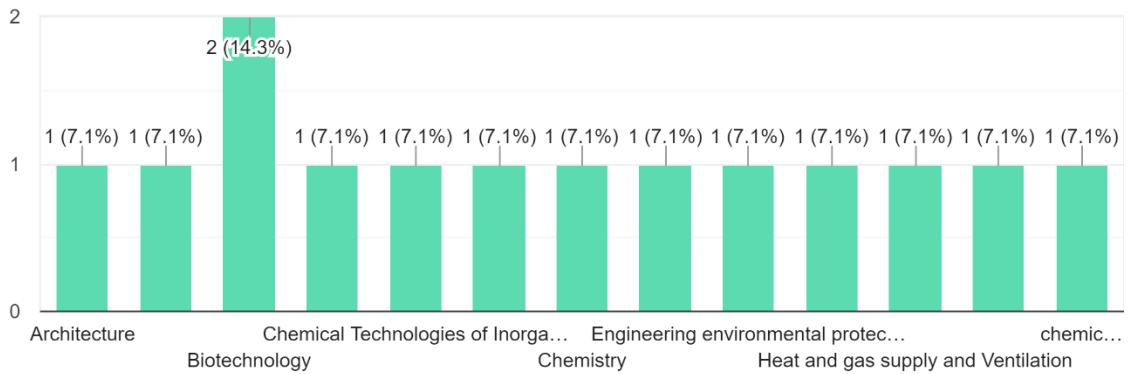
What was your education level in June 2021

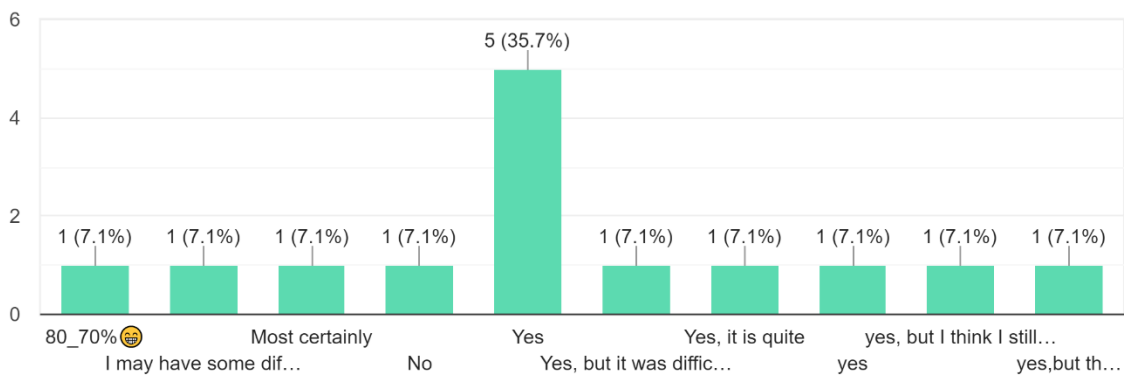
What is your speciality?

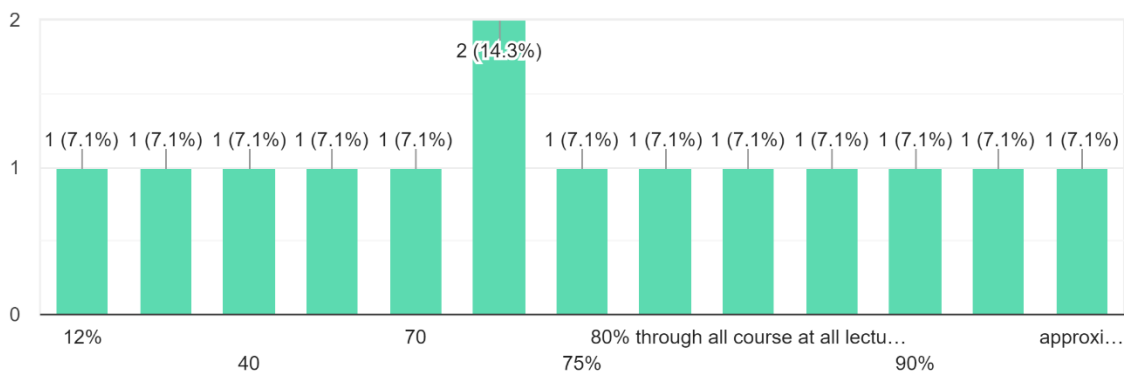
Did you feel you had sufficient English knowledge to follow the lectures?

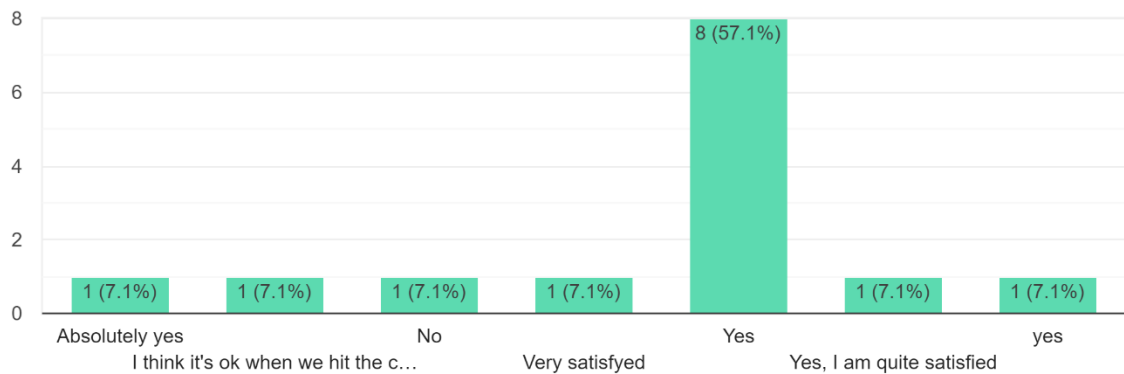
According to your impression, how many students (%) in the class could follow the lectures in English?

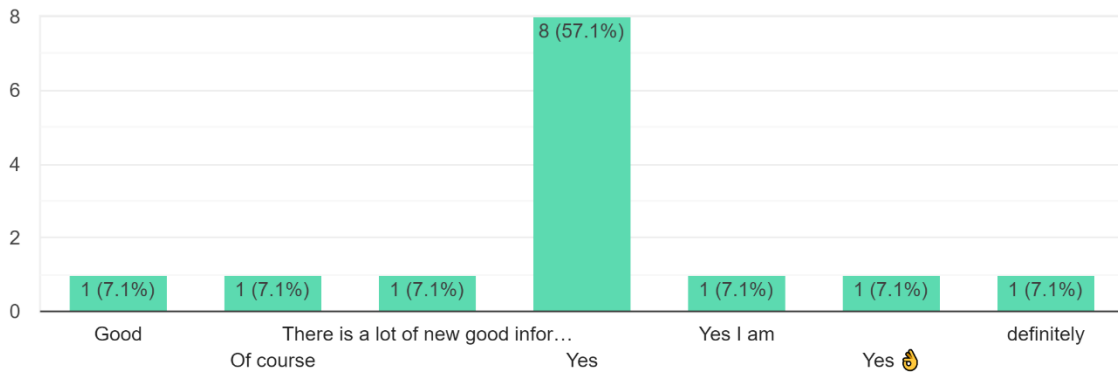

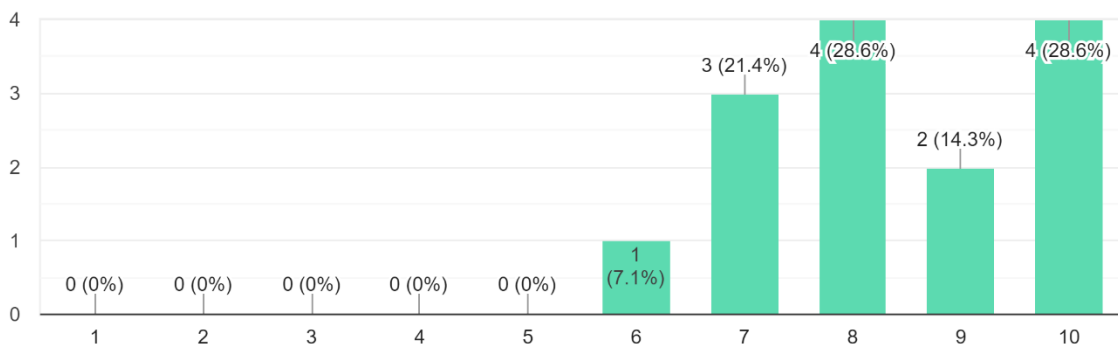

I liked the attentiveness of the teachers and their willingness to answer questions

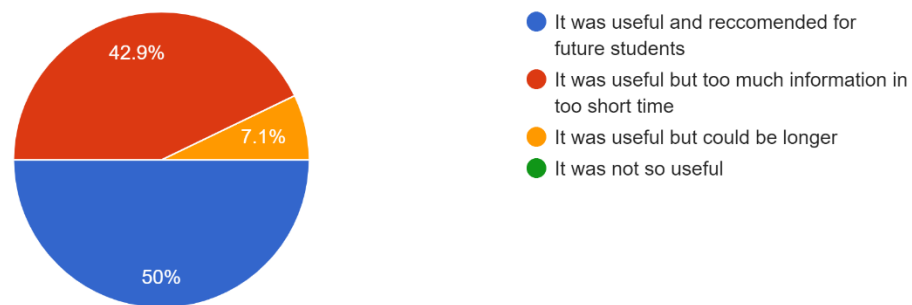

I was very happy with the educational process. I was glad to meet interesting people and even make new friends.

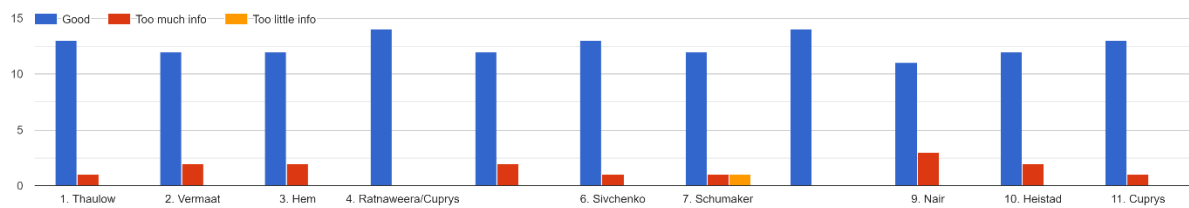

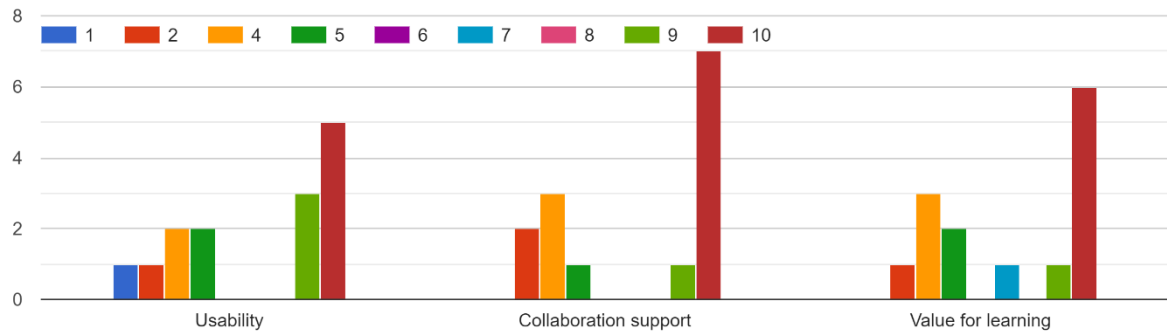

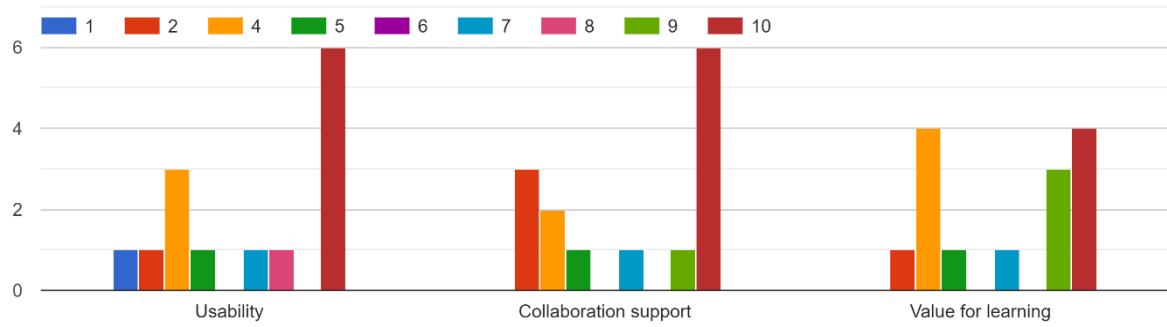

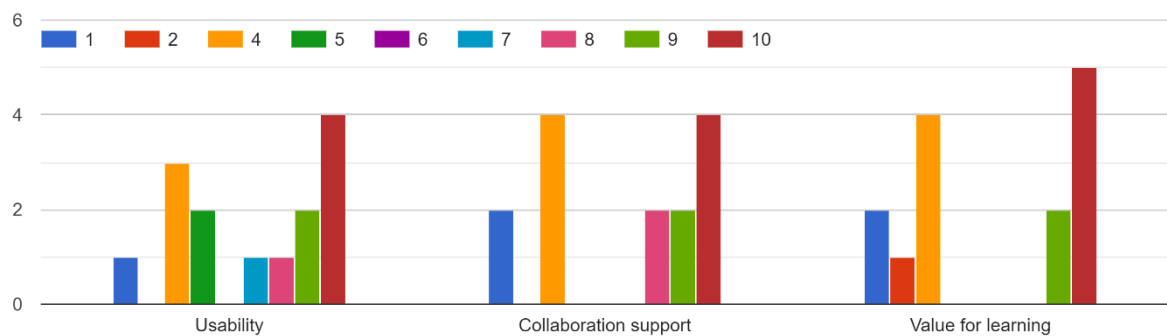

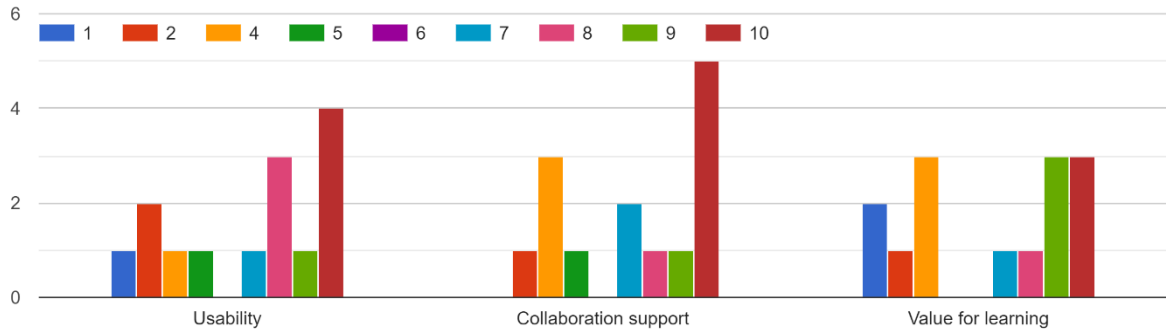

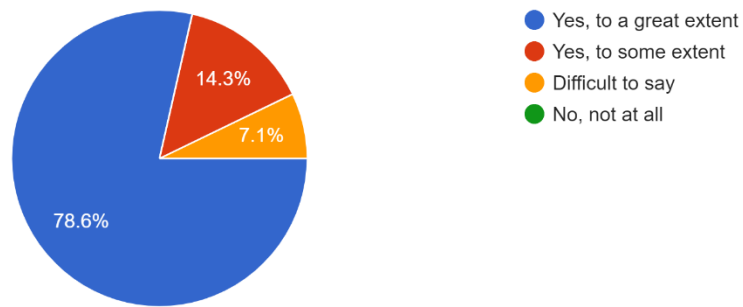


Adaptive Planning - Serious Game



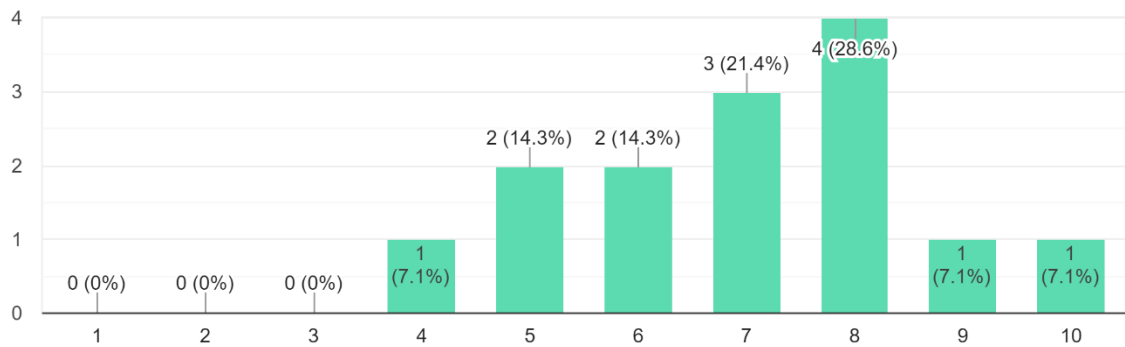
Do you think digital tools supported your learning experience in this course?
