1. Introduction

This document reports the first - Kick-off meeting of the Erasmus+ Capacity Building in the Field of Higher Education project "Strengthening of master curricula in water resources management for the Western Balkans HEIs and stakeholders" (SWARM), held at the coordinating University of Nis, on the 20th and 21st of December 2018. The meeting was chaired by Milan Gocić.

Meeting started at 10 with the SWARM participants' registration.

Milan Gocić opened the welcoming session and gave the floor to Zoran Nikolić.

Zoran Nikolić, advisor to the rector, welcomed the participants on behalf of the University of Nis. He presented the history, mission and vision of the University of Nis. He also highlighted the importance of this type of projects for Western Balkan countries and especially higher education institutions.

Milan Gocić presented the project to all participants. The most significant project segments were highlighted at this occasion and so the presentation represented an introduction to all following meeting sessions.

Summary:

Milan Gocić presented the project finance and financial reporting and informed the partners regarding the financial management of the project in line with the Grant Agreement and the Guidelines for the Use of the Grant. Also, it is highlighted how to fill EACEA templates such as Joint Declaration, Timesheet and Individual Travel Report as well as which type of supporting documents should be prepared.

Milan Gocić also presented and emphasizes the importance of dissemination activities as well as sustainability of some project results after the end of project funding i.e. LLL courses, master curricula and purchased equipment. He underlined the requirements of the Grant agreement such as visibility of project results, availability of materials produced and using of correct logo and disclaimer. All partners should be aware of the penalties in the case of non-compliance with publicity obligations. All partners should create own page on their institutional website to promote SWARM project.

Ljiljana Jevremović presented the project website and project management platform which will be used throughout the project lifetime. She underlined the need to upload pdf of all developed outcomes and also financial documents.

Summary:

Milan Gocić chaired the establishing of the project management structures (Steering Committee - SC, Project Management Committee - PMC, Quality Assurance Committee - QAC, WP Leaders). The voting procedure was explained. All committee members are adopted unanimously. In Annex III of this document the management structures are presented. He also presented EACEA evaluation report highlighting what should be done during implementation of some activities and what should be explained in more details in future plans and reports.

Minutes of the kick-off meeting

Kurt Glock presented the WP1 Analysis of water resources management in the Western Balkan region and underlined the need of joint work in order to develop all necessary reports on time. For that reason, partners need to suggest task leaders per each WP who will be responsible for the preparation of reports on their institution. The workshop on innovative practices in the EU water sector will be held in Vienna from 8-10 May 2019. Before the workshop, four reports should be created. WP1 Leader should develop adequate templates and define the structure of the reports.

Skoulikaris Charalampos presented the WP2 Development of competence-based curricula aligned with EU trends and highlighted that the achieved results are important for the sustainability after the end of project funding. Adaptation to national frame of developed master curricula is necessary. Special responsibility of partners from EU countries is to ensure a modern and innovative approach in the creation of learning materials and teaching methodology. WB partners need to prepare the list of current study programmes in the field of water resources management including the list of courses, short description of courses, ECTS and provide the link to them. Material should be provided in English.

Djurica Marković presented WP3 Development of trainings for professionals in water sector. The aim of WP3 is to identify knowledge and organizational gaps and develop effective training programmes for professionals in water sector. In order to develop material for the LLL courses, two reports should be prepared. First, EU partners need to prepare list of existing similar trainings and links to the materials. Second, WB partners in communication with EU partners should define questionnaire and analyse data.

Zakhar Maletskyi presented WP4 Implementation of developed master curricula and trainings. During his presentation, the kick-off members were divided into four groups with the lead from one of EU partners' institution. The conclusions are summarized and will be used during implementation of first three WPs. The WP Leaders of WP1, WP2 and WP3 should be aware of these achieved joint conclusions.

Maria Manuela Portela prepared presentation related to WP5 Quality assurance and monitoring. She highlighted strong collaboration and commitment from the partners.

Slaviša Trajković presented WP6 Dissemination and exploitation. He underlined the dissemination and exploitation issues and the need for the preparation of the Dissemination and Exploitation Plan. The partners should prepare the list of conferences, symposia or similar events where the project can be promoted.

Milan Gocić presented WP7 Project management and informed partners regarding Grant Agreement and Partnership Agreement and role of the coordinator and beneficiaries as well as presented future project activities and deadlines. He underlined that all WP Leaders should define a few deadlines for the achievement of project results and also plan B if something shouldn't be done on time. Also, all results need to be prepared a month before the final deadline in order to have enough time to have adequate discussion and implement all relevant recommendations on time. Darko Milogoric presnted topic related to the project management, reporting and National Erasmus+ office monitoring. He highlighted the need of joint work to achieve project results in line with the workplan and Logical Framework Matrix (LFM).
