This part of the meeting was chaired by Panagiotis Prinos. After discussion new and modernized subjects were summarized in one table and should be a part of set of courses.

Skoulikaris Charalampos presented plan for the development of SWARM unique set of courses and how to innovate existing and develop new master curricula for WRM in WB.

Panagiotis Prinos, Luís Ribeiro and Michael Tritthart presented theme-based training of teaching staff for acquiring new teaching and learning methods in Thessaloniki, Lisbon and Vienna, respectively.
