Strengthening of master curricula in water resources management for the Western Balkans HEIs and stakeholders

Project number: 597888-EPP-1-2018-1-RS-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP



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1. Introduction

This document reports the sixth PMC meeting of the Erasmus+ Capacity Building in the Field of Higher Education project "Strengthening of master curricula in water resources management for the Western Balkans HEIs and stakeholders" (SWARM), held in a hybrid mode (on-line using Zoom as a tool for the meeting and in-person applying all measures for organizing meetings in the COVID-19 period) on 9th September 2021. The meeting was chaired by Milan Gocić.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss future project activities in more details. All project partners took part into this meeting, excluding representatives from the UNS.

Summary:

Meeting started at 10:00.

Milan Gocić opened the meeting and said that two institutions have accredited their study programmes, two reaccredited modernized study programmes and three institutions modernized and adopted their study programmes by their internal bodies. We are waiting for decisions from AASKM and UPKM. The first generation of SWARM students have been enrolled. During next few months, the rest of the WB HEIs will enrol the first generation of students.

Zakhar Maletskyi presented activities in WP4. He highlighted two most important activities i.e. realization of master curricula and implementation of trainings for professionals in the water sector. He said that UNSA, UNS and UPKM have implemented the first year of their study programmes and that they should provide self-evaluation reports. The on-line training was organized successfully in



cooperation with the following HEIs: UNMO, UNS, UoM, UNI, UNSA in collaboration with the colleagues from the PWMC VV. AASKM and UPKM organized their trainings in-person in June.

Mladen Milanović presented three topics related to the promotional activities and WP6. As a first topic, he presented implemented dissemination activities. For the successful realization of the SWARM project goals, it is necessary to promote the project and to introduce the public to the project benefits.

Promoting the SWARM project has been planned using the:

- Website of the project (www.swarm.ni.ac.rs),
- Social media,
- > Different promo materials,
- Webinar Frontiers in Water Resource Management and
- Direct promotion of the SWARM at the project member Universities.

As a second topic, he presented the activity focused on organized info days for student enrolment. In total, seven events organized. AASKM and UNS should organize info days. The produced materials such as brochures and leaflets for promoting study programmes were presented.

As a third topic, he presented six organised roundtables for the non-academic sector. During the roundtables, training for professionals in the water sector was presented. Training objectives were:

- > Learn concepts in water resource management and water policy,
- > Gain skills in managing the quality of storm waters,
- Gain skills on water quality, its components and interventions,
- > Understand the causes of water resource conflicts and resolution measures,
- > Gain skills on water supply waste management techniques,
- ➤ Gain skills in using IT tools in water resource management.

One of excellent suggestion was to involve partners from programme countries in the roundtable implementation similar UNI was done.

Milan Gocić talked about symposium organization for the promotion of water resources management in WB countries. The draft version of the symposium was presented. The symposium will be organized in a hybrid mode (online and in-person). All participant will receive the Guide with the COVID-19 measures that should be followed during the stay on the Faculty of Technical Sciences untill Monday 20th September 2021. The session chairs were selected.

Partners from programme counties presented their plans for the organization of planned schools for WB students. In the following table the period for the organization was defined for each institution. The minimum number of students per school should be 4 and maximum 7.
