Participants expressed interest for new study programmes and digitalisation applied in the civil engineering sector.


The final remarks were regarding the possible cooperation with present companies and UNI.


The roundtable finished at 17:00.

### Motivation

One of the major environmental and sustainability challenges of the 21st century is **preserving and ensuring the most precious resource – water**. Carefully manage of this **limited resource** is urgent due to plenty of statistical facts.


